

AMNESIA! Noun Clauses with Yes/No Questions An English-Zone.Com Worksheet

Student 1 – DOCTOR: You have a new patient. Your patient has amnesia and can't remember anything. Carefully question the patient for some information.

Use noun clauses. Begin your questions with:

Could you tell me if...? Do you remember if...? Can you recall whether...? Do you know if...? Could you tell me whether...? (or your own words)

Student 2 - PATIENT: You have amnesia. You cannot remember anything. The doctor will ask you some questions, but you just can't remember.

Use noun clauses. Begin your sentences with:

I don't know if... I can't remember if...
I don't recall whether... I can't tell you whether...
I wish I could remember if... (or your own words)

Patient: I don't remember how old I am.

-ANSWER KEY-

Student 1 – DOCTOR: You have a new patient. Your patient has amnesia and can't remember anything. Carefully question the patient for some information.

Use noun clauses. Begin your questions with:

Could you tell me if...? Do you remember if...? Can you recall whether...? Do you know if...? Could you tell me whether...? (or your own words)

Student 2 - PATIENT: You have amnesia. You cannot remember anything. The doctor will ask you some questions, but you just can't remember.

Use noun clauses. Begin your sentences with:

I don't know if... I can't remember if...
I don't recall whether... I can't tell you whether...
I wish I could remember if... (or your own words)



EXAMPLE: How old are you?

Doctor: Could you tell me how old you are?
Patient: I don't remember how old I am.

1. Is your name?
Doctor: Hello, could you tell me if your name is Kelly?
Patient: I'm sorry. I don't know if my name is Kelly.
2. Do you have medical insurance?
Doctor: Can you tell me whether you have medical insurance or not?
Patient: I don't remember whether or not I have medical insurance.
3. Do you have any identification with you?
Doctor: Do you know if you have any identification with you or not? Patient: I wish I could remember if I have any identification with me.
4. Did you come to the hospital alone?
Doctor: Could you tell me if you came to the hospital alone?
Patient: I can't tell you if I came to the hospital alone or not.
5. Did a family member bring you to the hospital?
Doctor: Can you recall whether a family member brought you to the hospital? Patient: I don't recall if a family member brought me to the hospital or not.
6. Are you married?
Doctor: Do you know if you are married?
Patient: I really don't remember if I am married.
7. Do you have any children?
Doctor: Do you remember if you have any children?
Patient: I don't remember if I have any children or not.
8. Do you hurt anywhere?
Doctor: Can you tell me if you hurt anywhere?
Patient: I don't know if I hurt anywhere.
9. Did you hurt yourself?
Doctor: Do you know whether you hurt yourself or not?
Patient: I can't tell you whether or not I hurt myself.
10. Did you hit your head in a car accident?
Doctor: Can you recall if you hit your head in a car accident? Patient: I'm sorry, but I just don't remember if I hit my head in a car accident or not.

Doctor: Ok, that's all for now. I'll send the nurse in to give you some medication in a few minutes.

Patient: Thank you, Doctor.
